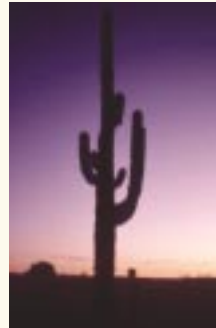


## Morongo Basin Counseling and Recovery Center

Our Child Guidance Clinic provides services to children. Our sister agency, Panorama Ranch, provides alcohol and chemical dependency recovery services to adults and adolescents.

## SPECIALIZED PROGRAMS

### Cal/Works:

A program designed to treat the behavioral or emotional disability that interferes with the individual's ability to make the transition from welfare to work.

### Groups:

Groups dealing with a variety of issues, such as anger, dual diagnosis, depression, parenting, stress, anxiety and many other topics.



### Consumer Support Groups:

These are non-therapeutic groups that are meant to offer support for individuals who have disorders. Information on how to manage symptoms and other areas of life are offered by members of the group, in a care and share fashion.
